RSVP Membership Cover Letter

RSVP volunteers choose how and where they want to serve—from a few hours to more than 40 hours a week. RSVP volunteers provide support to veterans and their families, help seniors live independently in their homes, mentor at-risk youth, provide critical support to communities recovering from disasters, and much more. *While Serving, RSVP volunteers also improve their own lives, by staying active and civically engaged.*

Eligibility & Benefits:

- RSVP volunteers must be at least 55 years of age
- Pre-service orientation
- Training from the agency where volunteer is placed
- Supplemental liability insurance for active volunteers
- Educational programs and literature
- Opportunities to meet other people with similar interests

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Supplemental Accident & Liability Insurance Coverage

All active RSVP volunteers are provided with three kinds of FREE insurance.

This is NOT a substitute for any other insurance you may carry now and ONLY provides coverage while you are engaged in volunteer work as an RSVP member. You will remain responsible for payment of any deductibles on your own insurance. Please remember you must be currently reporting hours to the RSVP office in order to maintain your active status and keep this insurance coverage in effect.

Brief Description of Coverage

1. Accident Insurance:

This covers you, the volunteer, for a personal injury arising from your volunteer activities. The insurance applies while you are participating in an activity sponsored by RSVP. This insurance pays where Medicare or your primary insurance and supplementary insurance leave off or will pay if you have no primary insurance. The amount of protection is \$50,000 maximum. The insurance company will also pay a \$2,500 Loss of Life benefit to your beneficiary. This is why RSVP must request that each volunteer list a beneficiary on the membership form they complete when they become a member of RSVP.

2. Personal Liability Insurance:

All volunteers enrolled in RSVP are provided a \$1,000,000 per occurrence protection for a personal injury or property damage liability claim arising out of the performance of the volunteer duties.

3. Excess Automobile Liability Insurance:

This coverage protects the volunteers for a bodily injury or property damage automobile liability claim arising out of related volunteer activities. The amount of protection is \$500,000 combined single limit Bodily Injury and Property Damage for each accident. Coverage does not include any automobile physical damage, just liability. You are **REQUIRED** to keep auto liability insurance in effect if you use your car in volunteer service.

***Note:** If you are involved in a volunteer related accident, notify the RSVP Director at 214-823-5700 immediately so we can file a claim on your behalf with our carrier. Thank you.
